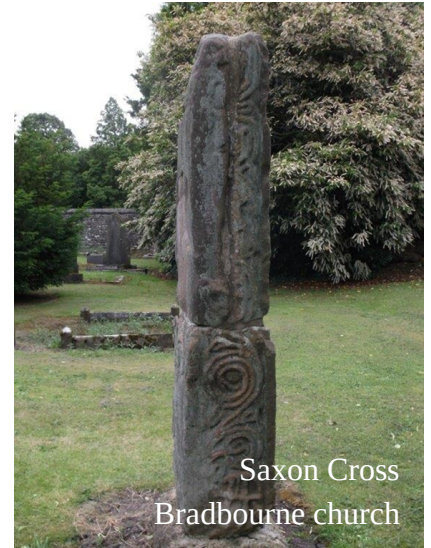


## Bradbourne and Ballidon – A Guided Walk by Jean Yates and John Morrissey

This walk complements the talk given by Jean Yates at Holbrook Moor Methodist Church on Tuesday 23 May 2017 at 10am - *"Dunstable Priory and the Derbyshire Connection"*.

The medieval Dunstable Priory acquired extensive land holdings in Derbyshire and the annals, which Jean Yates has extensively researched, detail information on how the Priory administered and developed them.



We plan to walk the field paths from Bradbourne to Ballidon. There is a lot to be seen of this deserted medieval village. Few people ever get in to see inside Ballidon church these days, but Jean Yates has negotiated with the Church Conservation Trust and we should be allowed entrance. Those who don't feel up to the walk can meet us at Ballidon.

We will then walk back to Bradbourne, meeting up once more with those not walking. In total there would be 4 miles of field paths covered. In Bradbourne churchyard we will look at the Anglo-Saxon cross before looking inside Bradbourne church.

Refreshments can be taken, if so wished, in the Village.
