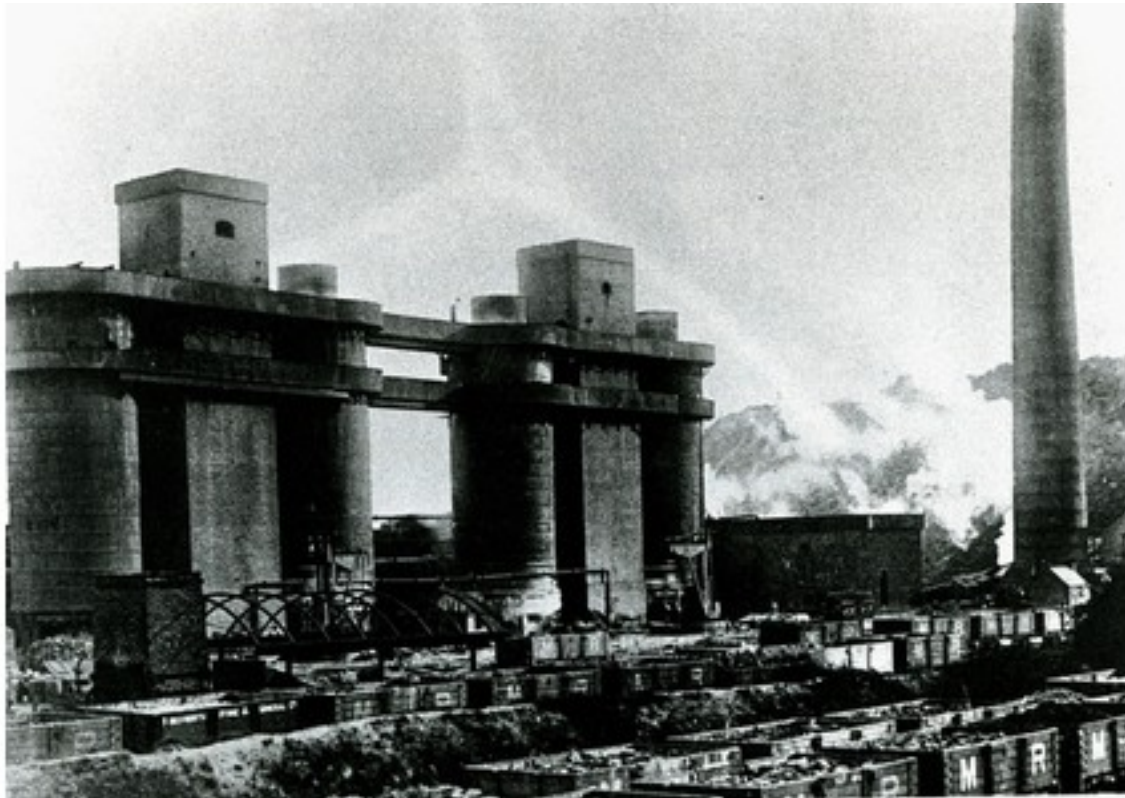


Pits, Pipes, Pots and Pig Iron. The Village History and Industrial Heritage of Denby.
