

English Cathedrals (Part 1 - Saxon to Decorated)



The course will look at: the evidence of Saxon Cathedrals and the changes brought about by the Norman Conquest; the development of Norman architecture from Winchester and St. Albans; late work at Peterborough and Ely. The Romanesque Frieze at Lincoln and sculpture at various venues will be reviewed. The arrival of Gothic will be shown through Canterbury, Lincoln, Wells and others, as will the stained glass of the early Gothic period. Salisbury will be studied as the classic Early English Cathedral and Exeter as the classic Decorated Cathedral.
