HOLBROOK 300 CLUB RULES

April 2018

- 1) The Holbrook 300 Club will operate under the lotteries and Amusements Act 1976. The organising committee is the Holbrook Arkwright Hall Village Community Centre (HAHVCC).
- 2) All proceeds, after distribution of the prize monies as specified in the rules below, will be assigned to the HAHVCC.
- 3) To be a member you must be 16 years of age at the time of membership. The Club Year is 1st. April to 31st. March in the following year. Failure to pay monthly subscriptions will invalidate entry in the next months draw. If any payments are missed then you may incur **disqualification from the annual draw.**
Minimum membership is one year from joining.
- 4) A member may hold as many numbered shares as they wish, at the cost of £2.00. per month. Membership will be renewable automatically on 1st. April each year. **New members may join at any time but will only be eligible to take part in the monthly draw the month after joining and in the annual draw providing half the annual subscription has been paid.**
- 5) The aim of the Club is to achieve 300 plus members, however, numbers may vary each year. Prize money will, therefore, vary accordingly and be calculated periodically on the percentages in rule 7.
- 6) Each single share in the Club will be allocated a permanent number, starting with number one and up to as many shares as are issued by the Club.
- 7) A minimum of 50% of all money staked less running costs, which will be minimal, will be returned to the winning members in prize money. The remainder will be assigned to the HAHVCC.
- 8) Subscriptions per share to be paid by one of three methods:
 - a) £24.00. by cash or cheque on or before 1st. April in the Club year of membership
 - b) £24.00. by annual bank standing order or £2 by monthly bank standing order

Members are encouraged to use the standing order method to reduce administration

- 9) The monthly draw will take place at a local venue towards the end of each month. Numbers will be drawn at random to allocate prizes. Each number can only win one prize in each monthly draw. All eligible numbers will be entered for the annual prize. The annual draw will be made during the March monthly draw. Members are invited and encouraged to attend the draws. All draws will be made in the presence of at least two committee members, one of which must be an officer of the committee.
- 10) All winners will be notified and their winnings will be issued by the club treasurer.
A list of winners will be posted on the HAHVCC notice board,
- 11) The Committee`s decision is final in all matters.
